REMEMAL OF REVOCABLE PERMIT

COVERING USE OF TRIBAL LAND AS AIRPLANE HANGAH SITE

Be It Resolved By The Papago Council:

That we hereby authorize Chairman Jose Ignacio to approve on our behalf, for a period of one year beginning January 1, 1937, and ending December 31, 1937, renewal of the revocable permit issued to N.A. O'Mara covering the use of 1.25 acres of tribal land as an airplane hangar site, which permit was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on March 2, 1936, and which requires the payment of an annual rental of \$24.00 per year.
