

RESOLUTION
of
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Whereas, the Stipulation of The Papago Tribe dated May 18, 1935 provides that 50% of the funds raised according to the terms of said stipulation shall be available for appropriation by the Papago Council for any tribal purpose when the Papago Tribe shall have adopted a Constitution and by-laws pursuant to the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. '984); and

Whereas, the Papago Tribe did ratify a Constitution and by-laws on December 12, 1936 and which was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 and has elected a council as provided therein; and

Whereas, the delegates to the Papago Council have found it burdensome to meet from personal funds, the expense incidental to attending regular meetings of the Council for the transaction of tribal business.

Now, therefore, Be it resolved by The Papago Council, that we respectfully request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to authorize the Superintendent of Sells Agency to expend the sum of \$250 from the fund "I.I.M., Acc't No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," for miscellaneous expenses of the Papago Council including payment of delegates and officers for attending regular meetings of the Council on April 3, May 1, and June 5, 1937, the pay of each delegate and officer to correspond to the amount set opposite the name of the district which he represents, as shown in the following schedule:
