

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 16

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby respectfully request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to obtain legislation by the Congress of the United States authorizing the use of \$3,000 now deposited in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the Papago Tribe under fund Symbol No. 147271, "Proceeds of Labor, Papago Indians of Sells Agency, Arizona," for the purchase of Papago baskets and other Papago handicrafts, the payment of travel expenses, wages and salaries, and other miscellaneous and incidental expenses incurred in connection with preparing and showing a Papago exhibit at the International Exposition to be held at San Francisco, California during the calendar year 1939; and

That such legislation also authorize the sale of all baskets and handicraft purchased from the above entitled fund, the proceeds of such sales to be deposited with the Superintendent of Sells Agency and credited to the fund "I.I.M., Acct. No. P-24, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," and such proceeds to be expended in accordance with Stipulation of The Papago Tribe dated May 15, 1935, under such rules and regulations as the Secretary of the Interior may prescribe consistent with the provisions of said stipulation.
