THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Whereas, Mr. Mike Curley, Manager of the Phelps Dodge Mine at Ajo, Arizona has employed hundreds of Papago workmen in the mine at good wages for several years past; and

Whereas, it has come to our attention that the said mine has paid in wages to Papago workmen during the past fiscal year a sum in excess of \$200,000.00; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the Papago Tribe to express its appreciation to Mr. Curley for his interest in the welfare of the Papago Tribe, now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby grant to Mr. Mike Curley of Ajo, Arizona, and party, as a token of friendship and appreciation, the right to hunt white wing, mourning dove, quail, and duck on the Papago Reservation, subject to the provisions of all Federal and State game laws and regulations.
