No. 24

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby waive any claim for damages in connection with the application of Pima County, Arizona for 5.638 miles of right-of-way within the Papago Reservation; said right-of-way to commence at a point on the East Boundary of the Papago Reservation where the present Tucson-Ajo Highway enters the same, (designated as Engineers Station. 0 plus 00 on map of definite location endorsed by the Superintendent of Sells Agency under date of November 18, 1937), and to terminate at station 297 plus 67.63 as shown on the said map.

Passed at Sells, Arizona, this 5th day of March, 1938.
