THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 33

Resolved by the Papago Council, that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs be, and he is hereby, respectfully requested to allot the sum of \$1200.00 to the Superintendent of Sells Agency from the fund "Proceeds of Papago Indian Reservation, Arizona, Rentals, etc., (Tribal Councils, 1939)", for the payment of traveling and other expenses of members of the Papago Council when engaged on business of the Papago Tribe, including the purchase of supplies and equipment: Provided, that not more than \$5.00 per diem in lieu of subsistence may be paid to any member of the Council from this fund.

Passed Sells, Arizona, this 4th day of June, 1938.
