

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 38

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of the Sells Agency during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1939, for all purposes incidental to the sifting, sacking, transportation, storage, and marketing of the tribal deposits of guano located within the Papago Reservation; Provided, that the Superintendent of the Sells Agency shall submit an accounting in writing to the Papago Council for all funds expended under this authority not later than July 1, 1939; Provided further, that all tribal guano prepared for market under this authority shall be advertised for sale under sealed bids and sold to the highest and best bidder by the Papago Council, or a Committee thereof selected by the Council to consider said bids.
