Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and consent to the use of funds deposited in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the Papago Tribe for the suppression and emergency prevention of forest fires on or threatening the San Kavier, Papago, or Gila Bend Reservations during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1939, in compliance with the suggestions contained in Indian Office Circular Letter "Forestry & Grazing", dated July 25, 1938, and signed by John Herrick, Assistant to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

Passed at Sells, Arizona, August 6, 1938, by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against.
