

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund Papago Tribe", the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000), which sum shall be available for the purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts for exhibit and sale at the 1939 Golden Gate International Exposition at San Francisco, California, and for the payment of the annual premium on the bond of the Treasurer of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board.

The sum herein appropriated shall be entered upon the books of the Superintendent of Sells Agency under the caption "I.I.M. Account No. P-10, Purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts, For Exhibit and Sale, San Francisco Exposition", and advances from this fund shall be made to the Treasurer of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board, from time to time as purchasing needs may require in the discretion of the Superintendent, and the amounts so advanced shall be deposited in the checking account of the said Treasurer with a bank located within the State of Arizona; Provided, That the bank selected as a depository shall be approved by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and shall carry insurance with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, an instrumentality of the United States Government which guarantees depositors against loss of deposits up to \$5,000.00; Provided further, that the bank selected as the depository for said funds shall be required to furnish a monthly statement of the condition of the Treasurer's account, including the cancelled checks paid during the period covered by the statement.

All purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts under the appropriation shall be paid for by check duly signed by the Treasurer of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board, at the time and place of purchase and the buyer shall take a receipt in duplicate from the seller, which receipt shall contain a description of the articles purchased, number of units of each, unit price, and total amount paid. One copy of the receipt to be turned in to the Sells Agency at such time or times to be prescribed by the Superintendent thereof, and one copy to be retained by the buyer.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 3, 1938, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
