

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 43

Resolved by the Papago Council, That we request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and he is hereby respectfully requested, to allot the sum of three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars included in the "Second Deficiency Appropriation Act, fiscal year 1938", to the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, for expenditure under appropriate regulations, in connection with defraying all expenses incidental to assembling, packing, shipping, exhibiting, and selling articles of Papago Art and Craftmanship at the Golden Gate International Exposition, San Francisco, California, including the pay and necessary expenses of persons employed in connection therewith; Provided, That personnel essential to carrying out the foregoing provisions may be appointed by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, by and with the advice and consent of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 3, 1938, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
