to purchasing, assembling, packing, shipping, exhibiting, and selling
articles of Papago art and craftmanship at the Golden Gate International Exposition. San Francisco, California, including the pay
and necessary expenses of person employed in connection therewith.

The foregoing Resolution was en October 1, 1938 dily enacted by a vote of 14 for, and 0 against, by the Papage Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a) Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its recision by the Secretary of Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
