

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 47

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to re-imburse Henry Throssell and Juan Harvey for travel expense incurred in attending meetings of the Livestock Marketing Committee of the Papago Council on September 10 and 27, 1938, and October 3, 4, 14, and 17, 1938, at the rate of \$4.00 per day, each, payable from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on November 5, 1938, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
