

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 49

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize the Superintendent of Sells Agency, in his discretion, to sell the increase from the tribal herd located at San Vicente Ranch, provided: the proceeds from such sales shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. "I. I. M. Acct. No. C-2, Cattle: Cooperative Expense";

Provided further, that we also authorize the Superintendent of Sells Agency to use the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No. C-2, Cattle: Cooperative Expense" for the exclusive purpose of meeting the expenses of the revolving cattle program of the Sells Indian Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 5, 1933, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
