

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 53

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby appoint Jose X Pablo and Peter Blaine as official interpreters of the Papago Council and to serve during good behavior, provided; that Jose X. Pablo shall be compensated for attending meetings of the Papago Council at the same rate of pay as is received by delegates to the Papago Council from the S'Chuk-Toak District;

Provided further, that the Superintendent of Sells Agency is requested and authorized to pay the said Jose X. Pablo at the rate specified herein, from any appropriated fund under the control of the Papago Council, upon the certification of the Secretary of the Papago Council.

Provided further, that the compensation of Peter Blaine as a delegate to the Papago Council shall be deemed sufficient to cover his duties as official interpreter.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (e), and Section 3, (a) Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
