THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Remon Garcia as Chief Judge of the Papago Court of Indian Offenses, and P. E. Chico as Associate Judge of the Papago Court of Indian Offenses, each to serve for a period of four years, commencing Jenuary 1, 1939 and terminating December 31, 1942.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 1 against, by the Papage Council. pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3. (b). Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, retified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its recission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6. Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe.
