Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize the Papago Loan Board to grant a loan to Henry Throssell of San Miguel in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-4, Papago Tribal Loan Fund," for the purpose of establishing a general store at Sells, Arizona.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 11 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
