

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL.

NO. 57

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," the sum of \$20.00 to be expended under the direction of the Secretary of the Papago Council for the purchase of postage, stationery, and other secretarial supplies for use in carrying on official correspondence of the Papago Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 4, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 4 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 954). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Galle Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
