

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 58

Whereas, the limitations covering expenditures of CCC-ID funds do not admit of the purchase of sufficient materials and equipment to carry out the type of program deemed to be of the greatest permanent benefit to the Papago Reservation; and

Whereas, it appears that a number of four-foot fresno scrapers are needed for dirt moving work on CCC-ID projects now under construction, now, therefore,

Be

It Resolved By the Papago Council, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated, from the fund "I.I.W. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), for the purchase, repair, and maintenance of fresno scrapers;

Provided, that the said fresno scrapers shall be procured by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency and shall be accounted for by him under the same rules and regulations as would apply if this property were acquired from regular Government funds.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 4, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for, and 5 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
