

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby appoint
Pete Blaine, Henry Throssell, and
Martin Maristo, to be members of a delegation to
represent the Papago Tribe before the Office of Indian Affairs in
Washington, D. C. at a time and date to be fixed by the Commissioner
of Indian Affairs;

Provided, that each member of the said tribal delegation shall
be compensated at the rate of \$5.00 per day for each day he is
absent from the Papago Reservation in connection with this mission;

Provided, further that the expenses authorized herein shall
be paid from the fund "Proceeds of Papago Indian Reservation, Arizona,
Rentals, etc.. (Tribal Council, 1939)"

The foregoing Resolution was on February 4, 1939, duly
enacted by a vote of 19 for, and 0 against, by the Papago
Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a),
Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe
on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 1y of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
of its approval by the Superintendent of the Gila Agency, subject
to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to
Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the
Papago Tribe.
