

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 61

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to reimburse Sacramento Jose of the Sif-Oidak District and Frank Rios of the San Xavier District for travel expense incurred in attending a meeting of the permanent Roads Committee of the Papago Council on February 20, 1939 at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on March 1, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 24 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
