

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 63

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Papago Loan Board to make a loan of \$100.00 each to the following individuals: Peter Blaine Martin Maristo and Henry Throssell for the purpose of enabling them to meet their traveling expenses in connection with a trip to Washington on official business of the tribe;

Provided, that each of the said delegates shall repay this loan from the travel expense allowed by Indian Office authority dated February 28, 1939, file reference Misc. 9341-39.

The foregoing Resolution was on March 4, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 24 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 18, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Salt Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
