OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 64

Be it resolved by the Papago Tribal Council, that whereaus,
it will be necessary to hold meetings in various districts to dis-
cuss different subjects discussed in Washington with various De-
partments by our delegates, to pay Martin Noriste, and Henry A.
Throssell at the rate of \$4.00 per day for all days spent in
holding these meetings.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 1, 1939, duly enacted
by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V.
of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on De-
cember 18, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1904, (48 Stat. 384). Said Resolution is effective as of the
date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Nezelle Agency,
subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pur-
suant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws
of the Papago Tribe.
