And Be It Further Resolved, that no part of the funds suthorized herein for the salary of the Secretary - Transurer of the Popago Council shall be used, unless, and until, the Council shall elect a qualified member of the tribo to perform the combined duties of Secretary of the Popago Council and Treasurer of the Popago Council as prescribed by Sections 3 and 4 of Article 1 of the By-Laws Of The Popago Tribe, and in addition thereto, the said Secretary-Pressurer shall also perform the duties of Clerk of the Sells Court of Indian Offenses and Clerk of the Popago Loan Board; and

De It Further Recolved, that we hereby respectfully request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to allot the sum of \$1578.00 from the fund "proceeds of Proceso Indian Reservation, Arizona, Kentals, etc. (Tribal Councils, 1910)" to the Superintendent of Sells Agency as soon after July 1, 1939 as may be practicable, and authorize the said Superintendent to pay the said sum to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council for deposit to his official checking account in a bank insured by the Federal Depocit Insurance Corporation; and

Be it Further Resolved, that we horeby authorize and request the Superintendent of the Sells Agency to pay to the order of the Secretary-Trensurer of the Sepage Council, the sum of \$2,746.00 from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. Do. F-SH, Contributed Bund, Papage Tribe." for deposit under the same conditions set forth in the preceding paragraph; provided, that no funds authorized herein may be transferred to the account of the Secretary-Freezeurer of the Papage Council until he shall first have filed a satisfactory curety bond in favor of the Papage Council in the penal sum of \$5,000.00, and until the said bond has been approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 6, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in int by Section 3. (a). Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on Becember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sella Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
