

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 57

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Chairman of the Papago Council to renew the permit covering the airplane hangar site occupied by H. A. O'Mara for a period of six months commencing January 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1939 for a consideration of \$12.00, said sum to be deposited to the credit of the Papago General Fund, Individual Indian Money Account No. P-3 at the Sells Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 6, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
