

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 65

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby respectfully recommend to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs that the licenses granted to the following Government Licensed Indian Traders on the Papago Reservation be renewed for the period beginning July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940.

And Be It Further Resolved, that we recommend to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs that he approve the sale of the Covered Wells Trading Post from Mrs. Bessie L. Savage to Mrs. Audrey Hines, and that he issue a license in favor of the said Mrs. Audrey Hines for the period beginning July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (c), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 954). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Salla Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
