

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 69

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Chairman of the Papago Council to renew the tribal permits covering the use and occupancy of tribal lands for business purposes, by the following licensed Indian traders, for the period beginning July 1, 1939 and ending June 30, 1940, at the same rates and under the same conditions set forth in the permits granted the said licensed traders for the period beginning July 1, 1938 and ending June 30, 1939, said permits having been approved by the Department of Interior under date of March 16, 1939.

And Be It Further Resolved that we grant a permit in favor of Mrs. Audrey Hines for the period beginning July 1, 1939 to June 30, 1940, at the same rate and covering the same land as that described in the permit granted Mrs. E.L. Savage to use and occupy tribal land for business purposes at Covered Wells (Quijotas) for the period beginning July 1, 1938 and ending June 30, 1939, said permit in favor of Mrs. Savage having been approved by the Department of the Interior on March 16, 1939.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (c), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
