

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 71

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby adopt William Vann Flores a one-half blood Papago Indian (3/4 Indian Papago & Cherokee), who was born at Appleton, Wisconsin on October 2, 1927 and whose father is Alonzo Flores a full blood Papago Indian and former resident of the San Xavier Reservation, and whose mother is Jessie Vann Flores who is a one-half blood Cherokee Indian.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1, (b), Article II of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
