

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 73

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby amend Resolution No. 42 enacted by the Council under date of September 3, 1938, to authorize, and the Papago Arts and Crafts Board is hereby authorized, to sell any handicrafts purchased under authority of Resolution No. 42, in any available Market.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly acted by vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Gila Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
