

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 74

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to pay the sum of \$50.00 each to Peter Blaine, Martin Moristo, and Henry Throssell for the purpose of reimbursing the same for extra expenses incurred in connection with a trip to Washington, D. C. during March, 1939 while engaged on official business of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing sums to be payable from the fund I.I.M. Account No. P-54 Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe.

This resolution is enacted pursuant to Indian Office letter dated May 6, 1939 file reference Misc. 21930-39 and addressed to the Superintendent of Sells Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly enacted by vote of 15 for, and 1 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). This resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
