Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorise and request the Superintendent of Sella Agency to pay the mum of 350.00 each to Peter Blaine, Martin Moristo, and Heary Throspell for the purpose of reimbursing the some for extra expenses incurred in connection with a trip to Exchington, D. C. during March. 1939 while engaged on official business of the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing sums to be payable from the fund I.I.H. Account No. P-54 Contributed Fund. Papago Erite.

This resolution is enacted pursuant to Indian Office letter dated May 6, 1939 file reference Misc. 21930-39 and addressed to the Superintendent of Sells Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1939, duly enacted against, by the 15 for, and __1.__ Panago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3. (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jenuary 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934: (48:Stat. 484). Raid Secolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 0, Article V of the Constitution and Ey-laws of the Panngo Tribe.
