

RESOLUTION

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby request the Superintendent, or other officer in charge of Sells Agency, to set aside \$1,000 from the fund, "I. I. M. Account No. P-4, Papago Tribal Loan Fund" as a separate account from which the expenses of the Loan Board shall be paid under his supervision for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 1, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1933, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
