

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 77

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated, the sum of \$4,000.00 from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency for the purchase of lumber, pipe, fencing and other miscellaneous supplies & Materials necessary or incidental to constructing roping and bucking chutes, Judges and band stand, contestant's bleachers, fencing the exterior of the Papago Fair and Rodeo grounds including fencing the inside of the race track, constructing stock pens construction of toilets and filling 1200 feet of the Menager Ditch, for the purpose of providing facilities for the holding of an annual fair, livestock show and rodeo as contemplated by Ordinance No. 4 of the Papago Council; Provided, that the location, type, and design of all structures erected from funds appropriated herein shall be subject to approval of the Board of Directors of The Papago Fair and Rodeo Association;

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1939, duly enacted by vote of _____ for, and _____ against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
