## RESOLUTION of THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 78

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Interior by letter dated June 23, 1939 has reviewed and approved Resolution No. 65 covering the Papago Council Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940; and

WHEREAS, Ers. Ida N. Wilson has voluntarily resigned the office of Secretary of the Papago Council; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Henry A. Throssell has voluntarily resigned the office of Treasurer of the Papago Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby accept the resignation of Mrs. Tda N. Wilson, Secretary, and Mr. Henry A. Throssell, Treasurer, effective immediately; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we hereby appoint Mr. Jones Narcho, Jr., to the position of Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council to perform the duties prescribed for the office of Secretary to the Papago Council and Treasurer of the Papago Council as prescribed by the By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.

AND IN ADDITION THERETO, the said Jones Narcho, Jr., shall perform the duties of Clerk of the Papago Loan Board and Clerk of the Sells Court of Indian Offenses at a salary of \$120.00 per month. This appointment shall be effective on and after the said Jones Narcho, Jr., has filed a surety bond in favor of the Papago Council in the penal sum of \$5,000.00 and after the said bond has been approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

PROVIDED that this appointee shall be allowed the same privileges with respect to annual and sick leave as are allowed employees of the United States Indian Service; and PROVIDED FURTHER that applications for annual and/or sick leave shall be subject to approval of the Chairman of the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was on July 1, 1939 duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2(f), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 18 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
