RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 81

RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize the Papago Loan Board to grant a loan to Cornelio Norris of San Kavier Reservation in the amount of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars from the fund, "I.I.M. Acct. No. P-4, Papago Tribal Loan Fund," to be used in his store business at San Kavier.

Paymonts on the loan are to be made monthly in the amount of not less than \$20.00 per month until the total amount of the loan and interest is paid in full, the total amount payable in full in not more than eighteen months, starting September, 1939.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 5, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Acency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
