RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to reimburse Sacramento Jese of the Sif-Cidak District in the amount of Eight (38.60) Bollars for travel expense incurred in attending a meeting of the permanent Roads Cormittee of the Papago Council on June 14, 1939, at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council, from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its reseission by the Secretary of the Interior; pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Fapago Tribe.
