

## RESOLUTION

OF

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 84

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated, an additional sum of \$1,000.00 from the fund, "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," to be expended for the purchase of supplies and materials including skilled labor, for use in the construction of facilities on the grounds of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association under the same provisions, conditions, and limitations as set forth in Resolution No. 77, enacted by the Council under date of July 1, 1939.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (49 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
