THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated, the sum of \$700.00 from the fund "I. I. E. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe," which shall be available for the payment of premiums awarded by the Papago Fair Board to winning exhibitors at the annual Papago Fair and Rodeo to be held at Sells, Arizona on November 10, 11, and 12, 1939, and such other miscellaneous expenses incurred by the Fair Board in the conduct of the annual fair, including payment of the annual premium on the bond of the Treasurer of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, and the Superintendent of the Sells Agency is hereby authorized and requested to transfer the above sum to the credit of the Treasurer of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, for deposit by him in the Revolving Fund of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association as provided by Ordinance No. 4.

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
