RESOLUTION

No. 86

OF

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby request and authorize the Superintendent of Sells Agency to reimburse the members of the Papago Council for travel expense incurred in coming to Sells, Arizona to attend a special meeting of the Council which could not be held because there was not a quorum present on September 23, 1939, at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council, from the fund, "I.I.M. Account No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on October 7, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
