

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 88

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$400.00 from the fund, "I. I. K. Acct. No. P-9, Papago Arts and Crafts Sale" to be available for the purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts for exhibit and sale, this sum to be expended under the conditions outlined in Resolution No. 42 of the Papago Council, enacted under date of September 3, 1939.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 4, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
