


RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL



No. 91

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No-C-3, Court Funds, Papago Indians.", the sum of \$300.00 to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency for the purchase of food stuffs and other supplies for the support of prisoners of the Sells Court of Indian Offenses, and for other miscellaneous court expenses.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 5, Chapter 4, of the Law and Order Regulations approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 27, 1935, and by Sections 3(a) and 3(b), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, and pursuant to Section 13 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
