

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 73

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby extend the authority for a period of one year from date hereof of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board, to buy and sell articles of Papago handicraft, and we hereby request and authorize the Superintendent of Sells Agency to transfer the remaining balance of \$1,062.34 in the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-9, Sale of Papago Arts and Crafts, San Francisco Exposition" to the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-10, Purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts, for Exhibit and Sale, San Francisco Exposition",;

PROVIDED that the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-9, Sale of Papago Arts and Crafts, San Francisco Exposition" shall be closed out and the title of the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No P-10, Purchase of Papago Arts and Crafts for Exhibit and Sale, San Francisco Exposition" shall be amended to read as follows: "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-10, Purchase and Sale of Papago Arts and Crafts".;

PROVIDED FURTHER that the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-10, Purchase and Sale of Papago Arts and Crafts" shall constitute a revolving fund from which sums may be advanced to the Treasurer of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board from time to time under the same conditions and limitations as prescribed by Resolution No. 42;

PROVIDED FURTHER that any previous resolution or ordinance, or parts of resolutions or ordinances enacted by the Papago Council which conflict with any provisions of this resolution, such resolutions or parts thereof as maybe in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.


The foregoing Resolution was on December 2, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 5, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat, 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
