

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 100

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to allot the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council for deposit by him in his official checking account, the said sum to be transferred from the fund "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-5, Papago Loan Board Expenses", to be available for defraying the expenses of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council in attending the Inter-American Conference on Indian Affairs, to be held in Patzcuaro, Mexico, April 14-24, 1940; and

Be it Further Resolved that we hereby authorize payment of the traveling expenses of the officers of the Papago Council listed in the first paragraph hereof, from Item No. 7 of the Budget of the Papago Council as approved May 9, 1939; provided

that the travel expenses authorized herein shall be paid out in accordance with the Standard Travel Regulations of the U. S. Government; and provided further

that the total amount shall not exceed \$350.00

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 8 for and 3 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
