Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Officers of the Papago Council to sign a repayment contract with the Superintendent of Sells Agency, to accept 33 head of young cattle and I bull to be placed in the Tribal herd and to be run at San Vicente Ranch on the Papago Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, purusuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
