

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe", the sum of Nine-hundred and ninety (\$990.00) Dollars to be expended under the direction of the Superintendent of Sells Agency by and with the advice and consent of the Livestock Committee of the Papago Council, for the support and maintenance of the Tribal herd during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941;

Provided that the sum herein appropriated shall become immediately available upon adoption and approval of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and by laws of the Papago Tribe.
