

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby grant a permit to Glenn Fisher for the purpose of collecting Sahuaro cactus spines on the Papago Indian Reservation, for a period of one year from date hereof, upon the payment of a fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said fee to be deposited to the credit of "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-3, Papago Council, Miscellaneous Receipts."

PROVIDED FURTHER that the number of employees of Mr. Fisher shall not at any one time exceed a total number of five including himself.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (h), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 3, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (46 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
