

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 106

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency or other officer in charge, to reimburse the members of the Committee selected to work out a license for Cattle Buyers for travel expense incurred in attending a meeting of the Committee on November 10, 1939, at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council, from the fund "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
