

Resolved by the Papago Council, that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency or other officer in charge, to reimburse the members of the Health Committee for travel expense incurred in attending a meeting with the Supervisor of Health Education held at Sells, Arizona on March 11, 1940, at the same rate of pay received when attending regular meetings of the Council, from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Interior on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
