Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize Chairman Jose Ignacio to execute the "Grant Acreement for Relief and Rehabilitation Grant to Organized Tribe" in behalf of the Papago Tribe, the said agreement to cover a grant of Ten Thousand (\$10,000)) Bollars from the United States Government to the Papago Tribe for use in connection with the construction of a community building at Sells, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vosted in it by Section 2, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant we Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
