

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 109

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to pay a gasoline bill in the amount of Twelve Dollars and thirty-one cents (\$12.31) incurred by the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Arts and Crafts Board in the performance of regular duties, from the fund, "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-10, Purchase and Sale of Papago Arts and Crafts". The above stated amount to be made payable to O'Mara's Indian Trading Post, Sells, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on June 1, 1940, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
