RESOLUTION OF THE PAPACO COUNCIL

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Chairman of the Papago Council to renew the tribal permits covering the use and occupancy of tribal lands for business purposes, by the rollowing licensed Indian traders, for the period beginning July 1, 1940 and ending June 30, 1941, at the same rates and under the same conditions set forth in the permits granted the said licensed traders for the period beginning July 1, 1938 and ending June 30, 1939, said permits having been approved by the Department of the Interior under date of Karch 16, 1939.

Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the repage Tribe.
